Plants purchased may not be resold as living plants and are intended to be used within **Sheridan County, WY only**. Payment must accompany order. If seedlings ordered are not available, a substitution or refund can be issued. **Cancellations will not be accepted after February 1st.**

Seedlings generally arrive at the beginning of May. However, due to shipping variability, pickup dates and times will not be set until the SCCD receives shipping confirmation from the nursery. At that time, SCCD will notify customers via email of pickup dates. Please make sure to provide your email below. **Timely pickup of plants is crucial to their survival.**
